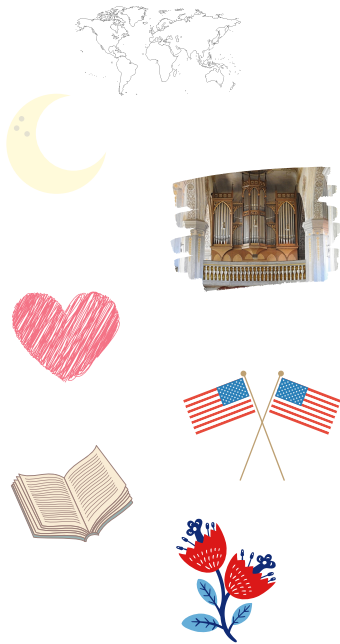




Antonín Dvořák
